

Website Privacy Policy

This Website Privacy Policy (this “policy”) describes the types of information Crescent Energy Company, (together with its subsidiaries, “Crescent Energy” or “we”) may collect from you (“you” or “your”) or that you may provide when you visit this [website](#) and its related sites (our “Website”) and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting and disclosing that information. Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, do not use this Website. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this policy. This policy may change from time to time. You are responsible for periodically visiting this Website and reviewing this policy to check for any changes. Your continued use of this Website after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check this policy periodically for updates, including any reflecting legal, technological or other developments.

1. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

Crescent Energy may collect personal information from you, such as your email address and any other information you provide to us when you use this Website. For example, we collect this information when you sign up to receive email alerts from us or register to view our webcast. When you visit this Website, we may also automatically collect IP addresses and certain non-identifying information that allows this Website to communicate with your computer during the visit. This information is not sold or otherwise disclosed to third parties for any purposes. We anonymize IP addresses collected twenty-four (24) hours after your visit. If you provide us feedback or contact us via email, we will collect your name and email address, as well as any other content included in the email, to assist in sending you a reply.

We also collect the information you provide to us, which may include personally identifiable or sensitive information. Crescent Energy does not seek sensitive information from you on this Website. Sensitive information includes a number of types of data relating to: race or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or other similar beliefs, trade union membership, physical or mental health, or biometric data. We recommend that you not provide any sensitive information unless strictly necessary or required by law. However, if you do provide such information, Crescent Energy accepts your explicit consent to use that data in the ways described in this policy or in the ways described by you or us at the point where such information is disclosed to us.

2. Security

Although we use commercially reasonable efforts to help protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of personal information transmitted to this Website. Please be aware that there is no such thing as “perfect security” on the Internet, and third parties may unlawfully intercept or access transmissions or private communications, and accordingly email and other transmissions to and from this Website or made via this Website may not be secure. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. No data transmission or storage system

can be made 100 percent secure. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on this Website.

3. Information from Children

5. Do Not Track

8. Our Retention Policies

Personal information may be kept for as long as it is required for legitimate business purposes, to perform contractual obligations, or where longer, for such longer periods as are required or permitted by applicable legal or regulatory obligations.

We may also be allowed to retain personal information for a longer period if you have given consent to such processing, as long as such consent is not withdrawn. Furthermore, we may be obliged to retain personal information for a longer period whenever required to do so for the performance of a legal obligation or upon order of any governmental or regulatory authority.

9. California Privacy Rights

Right to Know. You have the right to know and see what personal information we have collected about you over the past 12 months, including:

- The categories of third parties with whom we have shared your personal information; and

- The specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you.

Right to Delete. You have the right to request that we delete the personal information we have collected from you. There are a number of exceptions, however, that include, but are not limited, to when the information is necessary for us or a third party to do any of the following:

- Complete your transaction;
- Provide you a good or service;
- Perform a contract between us and you;
- Protect your security and prosecute those responsible for breaching it;
- Fix our system in the case of a bug;
- Protect the free speech rights of you or other users of this Website;
- Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act (Cal. Penal Code § 1546 et seq.);
- Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interests that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws;
- Comply with a legal obligation; or
- Make other internal and lawful uses of the information that are compatible with the context in which you provided it.

How to Exercise Your Rights. To exercise any of your California access or deletion request rights, please submit a verifiable consumer request to our contact email address at the bottom of this policy. To the extent applicable, we will contact you to confirm receipt of your request under the CCPA and request any additional information necessary to verify your request. We verify requests by matching information provided in connection with your request to information contained in our records. You may also designate an authorized agent to make a request under the CCPA on your behalf, provided that you provide a signed agreement verifying such authorized agent's authority to make requests on your behalf, and we may verify such authorized person's identity using the procedures above. The verifiable consumer request must:

- Provide sufficient information that allows us to reasonably verify you are the person about whom we collected personal information or an authorized representative, and
- Describe your request with sufficient detail that allows us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond to it.

We will not be able to respond to your request or provide you with specific pieces of personal information if we cannot verify your identity and authority to make the request. Our goal is to respond to any verifiable consumer request within forty-five (45) days of our receipt of such request.

10. International Use
